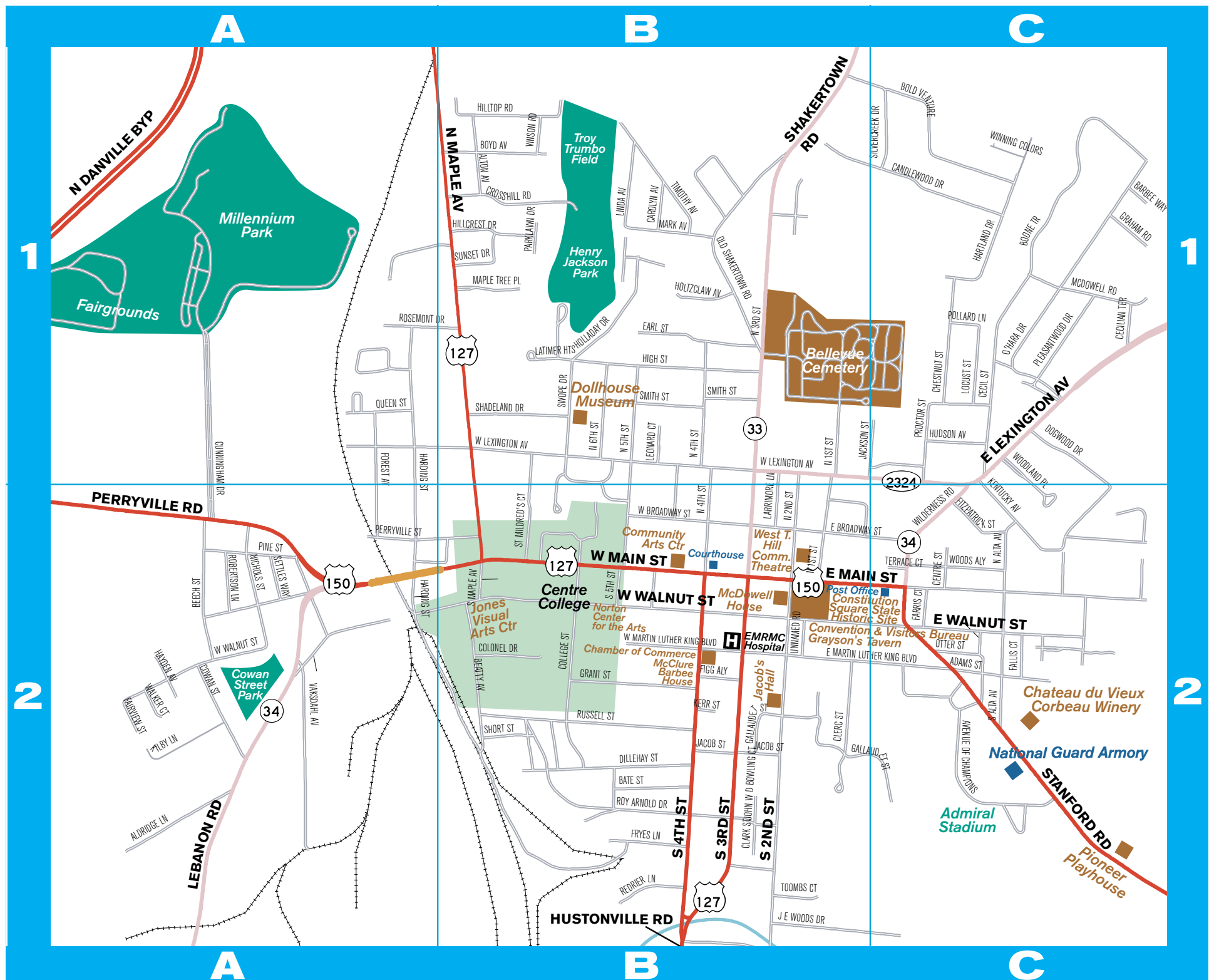

Perryville Battlefield E2

The Battle of Perryville was one of the bloodiest battles in the Civil War and the most important engagement fought in Kentucky. Today, visitors from across the country venture to the 600 acres of preserved and interpreted battlefield land for a look into our history or even an afternoon picnic. Now home to a completely renovated museum, the *Perryville Battlefield* is a must see for history lovers. Dr. Ephraim McDowell made medical history on Christmas morning 1809 when he performed what is widely regarded as the first successful abdominal surgery. Carefully restored, the *McDowell House and Apothecary* stand on their original sites. The Apothecary Shop houses one of the world's most extensive collections of historic apothecary equipment and related artifacts. In the heart of Danville, *Constitution Square State Historic Site* breathes with the history of our great state. On June 1, 1792, Kentucky's first constitution was signed on these historic grounds. While in Danville, don't miss the log replica of the meeting house, along with the courthouse, jail, and the original building that housed the first post office in the "West."
